	WORKFORCE	Invest in a skilled workforce Invest in developing a skilled and diverse waste management workforce with appropriate support and defined career paths	Key Activities and KPIs	100% of NHS trusts and foundation trusts have a dedicated waste manager role (at least 0.5 FTE) by 2023, funded from their own resources, and 100% of other NHS providers have identified accountable individuals for waste management


